A Note from Pastor Tim

Recently, I completed a leadership training called "History Makers Journey" with the International Leadership Institute (ILI) for the Global Methodist Church. A statistic was shared that compelled me to pray more passionately for those who face a Christ-less eternity: Approximately 40% of seven billion people have never heard the glory of who Jesus Christ is according to the Scriptures.

Reaching the sheer number of people who do not belong to Jesus Christ might seem impossible. It might seem as impossible as harvesting a seven-billion-acre field without any help or no tools. However, our Lord Jesus instructed us to pray that workers would be raised up and sent out into the "fields of harvest" (Matthew 9:35-37).

What if we commit to pray for Jesus' prayer to be answered through our lives this month as we walk to Easter Sunday on March 31st?

In addition to praying, we are planning a "Sit with Me" Sunday on March 24th and will provide invitation cards during the month of March. The reason for "Sit with Me" Sunday is that approximately 80% of un-churched people would most likely attend worship if they were asked by someone who cares about them. I suspect that many disconnected Christians are open and willing too.

Is there a family member, friend, associate, or neighbor that is waiting for you to invite them to sit with you?

We'll take a moment during the services to talk about what this means, why it matters, and how to do it.
